## USIM's MODERN CAMPUS IN THE CITY OF KNOWLEDGE- BANDAR BARU NILAI

USIM's modern campus is strategically located in Bandar Baru Nilai. The campus is located in the Multimedia Super Corridor, close to the Kuala Lumpur International Airport, Putrajaya and Cyberjaya. USIM is about 30 minutes drive from KLIA and about 45 minutes drive from KL. The area of the campus is 566 acres

The approach to USIM is easily visible with directional signboard while approaching Nilai Toll Interchange on the PLUS KL-Seremban Highway. The landmarks of USIM are the big USIM signboard on the slope close to the Nilai Indoor Stadium and the new Chancellory Building with the blue dome on the highest peak in the campus.

USIM has moved from its Temporary Campus in Pandan Indah in July 2005. By August 2005 the following buildings have been completed and occupied which can accommodate 4,000

students. The buildings are: Faculty of Syariah and Law (capacity 2,000 students), Faculty of Leadership and Management (capacity 2,000 students), two Central Lecture Halls (capacity 500 students each), ICT Centre (which served as temporary Chancellory), temporary library building which also housed the Academic Division, temporary building for Student Affairs (ex-Contractor's Site Office), temporary building for the Development Unit (ex-PMC's Site Office), Student Facility Centre and outdoor sports facilities.

Two more Central Lecture Halls (capacity 500 students each), the Chancellory Building and the six storey Science Laboratory building have been completed in 2007. The Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences and the Faculty of Dentistry are still located in Pandan Indah.

The University rents apartment buildings in Nilai and converts them as Colleges of Residence for student accommodation. The University provides bus shuttle services to transport students from the Colleges of Residence to campus and also transportation facilities to support student off-campus activities.

By the end of 2008, many more facilities will be completed under the Ninth Malaysia Plan. Various buildings are under construction. The facilities that will be completed are:

1. Faculty of Economics and Muamalat and Faculty of Quran and Sunnah Studies.
2. Student Affairs and Medical Centre, Library building, Commercial Centre and Cafeterias, Pavilion and Synthetic Track and Key Staff Quarters.

The Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences, Faculty of Dental Surgery, the Faculty of Science and Technology and the TAMHIDI Centre buildings are being planned and planned

to be completed by the end of the Ninth Malaysia Plan. It is targeted by 2010, USIM Campus can accommodate 10,000 students. The Nilai Indoor Stadium is now under USIM's management since June 2007.
